Bengal Police Vacancy for Sub Inspector:

The WBPRB has announced 1,131 vacant positions for the Sub Inspector role. 



Bengal Police Vacancy 2024 - Step-by-Step Process

The application window for WB Police Constable was open from March 7, 2024, to April 5, 2024. Meanwhile, the application window for the SI position was open from March 9, 2024, to April 7, 2024, giving candidates approximately a month to apply.

- To apply online, you have to visit the [official website](#) of the West Bengal Police Recruitment Board.
- Thereafter, click on the "Apply Online" section.
- Choose the respective exam name, either WB Police Constable or SI.
- Fill in all the details, such as name, date of birth, email ID, mobile number, father's name, address, and education qualification.
- Now, submit the form and take a printout for future reference.

Bengal Police Vacancy 2024 - Exam Pattern

Uncertainty about the exam format can lead to unnecessary stress and anxiety. Understanding the pattern gives a sense of control and confidence, reducing anxiety levels during the exam.

The exam pattern for Bengal Police Constable is as follows:

- The recruitment process for Constable positions in the West Bengal Police includes a Written Examination, followed by a Physical Measurement Test (PMT), Physical Efficiency Test (PET), and Interview.
- The written exam will consist of 85 objective-type questions.
- It will be OMR-based and follow a multiple-choice question (MCQ) pattern.
- The duration of the written exam will be one hour.

The exam pattern for Bengal Police SI is as follows:

- The recruitment for the posts of Sub-Inspector (UB) and Sub-Inspector (AB) in West Bengal Police involves qualifying in the Preliminary Examination, which serves as a screening test. This is followed by the Physical Measurement Test (PMT), Physical Efficiency Test (PET), Final Combined Competitive Examination, and a Personality Test.
- The preliminary examination will be of 200 marks with a duration of 90 minutes. Moreover, it's important to note that the preliminary examination will serve as a screening test to select candidates for the Physical Measurement Test (PMT) and Physical Efficiency Test (PET).
- The Final Combined Competitive Examination will consist of three papers with conventional type questions. Moreover, the exam will be of 200 marks.

The syllabus for Bengal Police Constable is as follows:

- General Awareness and Knowledge - 25 marks
- English - 10 marks
- Elementary Mathematics (Madhyamik standard) - 25 marks
- Reasoning and Logical Analysis - 25 marks

To succeed in the Bengal Police SI Exam 2024, it's vital for you to understand the WBP SI Syllabus 2024. Knowing the subjects will help you plan your studies, pick the right materials, and manage your time well. Here's a brief overview of the syllabus:

Preliminary Exam:

- General Studies
- Logical & Analytical Reasoning
- Arithmetic

Final Combined Competitive Examination:

- Paper I: The Paper I of Final Combined Competitive Examination includes the General Studies and Arithmetic paper which is worth 100 marks (50 marks for General Studies, along with 25 marks each for Logical & Analytical Reasoning and Arithmetic). The exam duration is 2 hours.
- Paper II: The Paper II of Final Combined Competitive Examination for Sub-Inspectors in West Bengal Police includes an English paper worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.
- Paper III: It includes a paper on Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali, worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.
