


After passing the preliminary examination, the Final Combined Competitive Examination will cover four subjects:

- General Awareness and General Knowledge
- English
- · Elementary Mathematics (Madhyamik standard)
- Reasoning and Logical Analysis

Complete WBP SI Syllabus - Exam Pattern

Understanding the WB SI exam format is akin to having a detailed map for your journey. This knowledge is essential as it aids in effective preparation, provides clear readiness guidelines, and boosts your confidence during the actual exam. Let's break down the WB SI exam pattern for you.

The West Bengal Sub Inspector examination comprises four stages:

- Preliminary Examination 200 marks
- Physical Measurement Test (PMT) & Physical Efficiency Test (PET)
- Final Combined Competitive Examination 200 marks
- Personality Test 30 marks

Shall we explore the exam pattern for each of these stages?

Preliminary Examination:

- The exam includes sections on General Studies, Logical & Analytical Reasoning, and Arithmetic, totaling 200 marks.
- The General Studies section has 50 questions worth 100 marks, the Logical & Analytical Reasoning section has 25 questions worth 50 marks, and the Arithmetic section has 25 questions worth 50 marks.
- The exam duration is 90 minutes.

Physical Measurement Test (PMT):

• In the Physical Measurement Test, your physical attributes will be evaluated based on criteria set by the West Bengal Police Recruitment Board. Detailed criteria can be found in the official notification snippet below:

During the Physical Efficiency Test (PET), your performance will be assessed based on criteria that include tasks such as the 400-meter run or 800-meter run. Detailed specifications can be found in the excerpt from the official notification below:

F. Physical Efficiency Test (PET): -

| Sl. No. | Class of Candidate | Minimum Efficiency |
|------------|---|--|
| 1. | Male candidates (Both Unarmed & Armed Branch) | 800 metres run within 3 minutes. |
| 2. | Female candidates (Unarmed Branch) | 400 metres run within 2 minutes. |
| 3. | Transgender Candidates (Both Unarmed & Armed Branch) | 400 metres run within 1 minute 40 seconds. |

Final Combined Competitive Examination:

The Final Combined Competitive Examination will consist of three papers with conventional-type questions:

- Paper I: General Studies and Arithmetic, totaling 100 marks (50 marks for General Studies, 25 marks for Logical & Analytical Reasoning, and 25 marks for Arithmetic), with a duration of 2 hours.
- Paper II: English, worth 50 marks, lasting 1 hour.
- Paper III: Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali, worth 50 marks, lasting 1 hour.

Personality Test:

A select number of candidates who meet all eligibility criteria for the position will be chosen based on merit from the results of the Final Combined Competitive Examination. They will then be invited to participate in the Personality Test, which requires a minimum passing score of 8 marks.


