

Eligibility of WBP SI 2024

Nationality:

You must be a citizen of India to be eligible for the WB Police SI exam 2024.

Age Limit:

You must be at least 20 years old and not more than 30 years old as of 01.01.2024. Additionally, there are age relaxations. Here are the details:

- The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates, and by 3 years for Other Backward Classes-A, Other Backward Classes-B, and transgender persons.
- For departmental candidates of the West Bengal Police with the requisite qualifications, the upper age limit is 35 years. This limit is further relaxable by 5 years for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates, and by 3 years for Other Backward Classes-A, Other Backward Classes-B, and transgender persons.

Educational Qualification:

- You must have a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or its equivalent.
- Moreover, you must be able to speak, read, and write Bengali language. However, this requirement does not apply to permanent residents of hill sub-divisions in Darjeeling and Kalimpong Districts. For applicants from these hill subdivisions, the provisions of the West Bengal Official Language Act, 1961 will apply.

Eligibility of WBP SI 2024 - Exam Pattern

This will be followed by the Physical Measurement Test (PMT), Physical Efficiency Test (PET), Final Combined Competitive Examination, and Personality Test conducted by the West Bengal Police Recruitment Board.

Preliminary Examination



- The exam includes sections on General Studies, Logical & Analytical Reasoning and Arithmetic, with a total of 200 marks.
- The examination consists of 100 marks in General Studies with 50 questions, 50 marks in Logical & Analytical Reasoning with 25 questions, and 50 marks in Arithmetic with 25 questions.
- The exam lasts for a duration of 90 minutes.

Physical Measurement Test (PMT)

In the Physical Measurement Test, you will be assessed based on physical criteria established by the West Bengal Police. The specific criteria can be found in the snippet below from the official notification:

Physical Efficiency Test (PET)

Only if you qualify in the PMT you will be eligible to appear in the PET. The specific details of the Physical Efficiency Test can be found in the snip below taken from the official notification:

F. Physical Efficiency Test (PET) :-

Sl. No.	Class of Candidate	Minimum Efficiency
1.	Male candidates (Both Unarmed & Armed Branch)	800 metres run within 3 minutes.
2.	Female candidates (Unarmed Branch)	400 metres run within 2 minutes.
3.	Transgender Candidates (Both Unarmed & Armed Branch)	400 metres run within 1 minute 40 seconds.

Final Combined Competitive Examination

The Final Combined Competitive Examination will include three papers with conventional-type questions:

- **Paper I:** General Studies and Arithmetic, totalling 100 marks (50 marks for General Studies, 25 marks for Logical & Analytical Reasoning, and 25 marks for Arithmetic), with a duration of 2 hours.
- **Paper II:** English, worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.
- **Paper III:** Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali, worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.

Personality Test

If you meet all the eligibility of WBP SI 2024 and are selected merit-wise based on the results of the Final Combined Competitive Examination, you will be called to appear at the Personality Test. The minimum passing mark for the personality test is 08 (eight).
