### Age Limit

- You must be aged between 20 and 27 years old as on 01.01.2023.



Additionally, there are specific exceptions to this age limit, as detailed below:

- The upper age limit is relaxable by:
  - 5 years for SC and ST candidates
  - 3 years for OBC candidates of West Bengal only
  - 3 years for Transgender persons
  - Up to 35 years for departmental candidates of Kolkata Police with requisite qualifications
- Further relaxation for departmental candidates:
  - Additional 5 years for SC and ST candidates
  - Additional 3 years for OBC candidates

Please note that only the Date of Birth recorded in the Madhyamik or equivalent admit card/certificate will be accepted as valid proof for age verification.

## Educational Qualification

- You must have a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or its equivalent.

## Language Requirement

- Must be able to read, write, and speak Bengali.
- Exemption for permanent residents of hill sub-divisions of Darjeeling and Kalimpong Districts, subject to the West Bengal Official Language Act, 1961.

## Physical Measurements

You will undergo a Physical Measurement Test (PMT) to assess your height, weight, and chest only if you qualify in the preliminary examination.

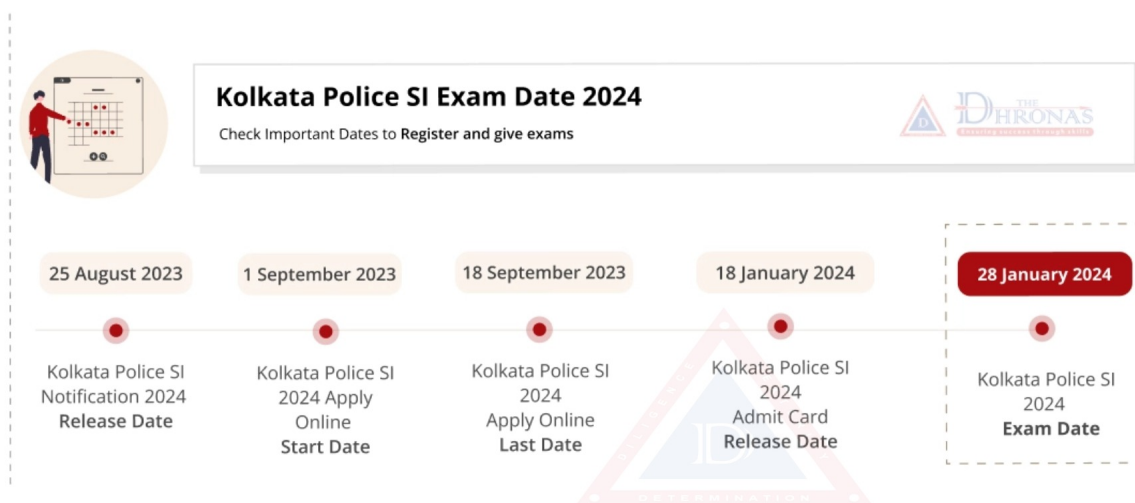

## Kolkata Police SI Exam Pattern 2024

### Preliminary Examination:

- The Preliminary Exam will cover General Studies, Logical & Analytical Reasoning, and Arithmetic, with a total of 200 marks.
- The duration of the examination is 90 minutes.
- This Preliminary Examination will serve as a screening test for the Physical Measurement Test and Physical Efficiency Test.
- The exam will be an OMR-based, multiple-choice question (MCQ) written test.

### Final Combined Competitive Examination:



It consists of three papers with conventional-type questions

- **Paper I:** General Studies and Arithmetic for 100 marks (50 marks for General Studies, 25 marks for Logical & Analytical Reasoning, and 25 marks for Arithmetic), with a duration of 2 hours.
- **Paper II:** English for 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.
- **Paper III:** Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali for 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.

## Kolkata Police SI Syllabus 2024

The Kolkata Police SI recruitment process consists of two written exam stages: the Preliminary exam and the Final Combined Competitive Exam. Below, we have provided the detailed official syllabus for both stages, intended for candidates who fulfil the Kolkata Police SI Eligibility Criteria.

### Preliminary Exam

- General Studies
- Logical & Analytical Reasoning
- Arithmetic



### Final Combined Competitive Exam

Paper 1: General Studies and Arithmetic

- General Studies: Questions to test General Knowledge in different spheres.
- Logical & Analytical Reasoning: Questions to test logical and analytical ability.
- Arithmetic: Questions based on the syllabus of Madhyamik Examination of the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education.

Paper 2: English

- Drafting of a report from the points or material supplied.
- Translation from Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali to English, and vice versa.
- Condensing of a prose passage (summary/precis).
- Correct use of words, correction of sentences, use of common phrases, synonyms, and antonyms, etc.

Paper 3: Bengali / Hindi / Urdu / Nepali





- Drafting of a report from the points or material supplied.
- Translation from English to Bengali and English to Nepali for candidates who have opted for 'Bengali' or 'Nepali,' respectively.
- Translation from Hindi/Urdu to Bengali for candidates who have opted for Hindi or Urdu.
- The translation shall be of 20 (twenty) marks.

## Kolkata Police SI Post and Salary 2024

Upon successfully passing the Kolkata Police SI exam, you will be appointed to one of the following positions within the Kolkata Police:

- Sub-Inspector/Sub-Inspectress (Unarmed Branch)
- Sub-Inspector (Armed Branch)
- Sergeant

Additionally, the pay scale for these positions is Level 10 in the pay matrix, which ranges from Rs. 32,100 to Rs. 82,900.
