Vijay Diwas 2023: The Role of Indian Army, Air Force, and Navy

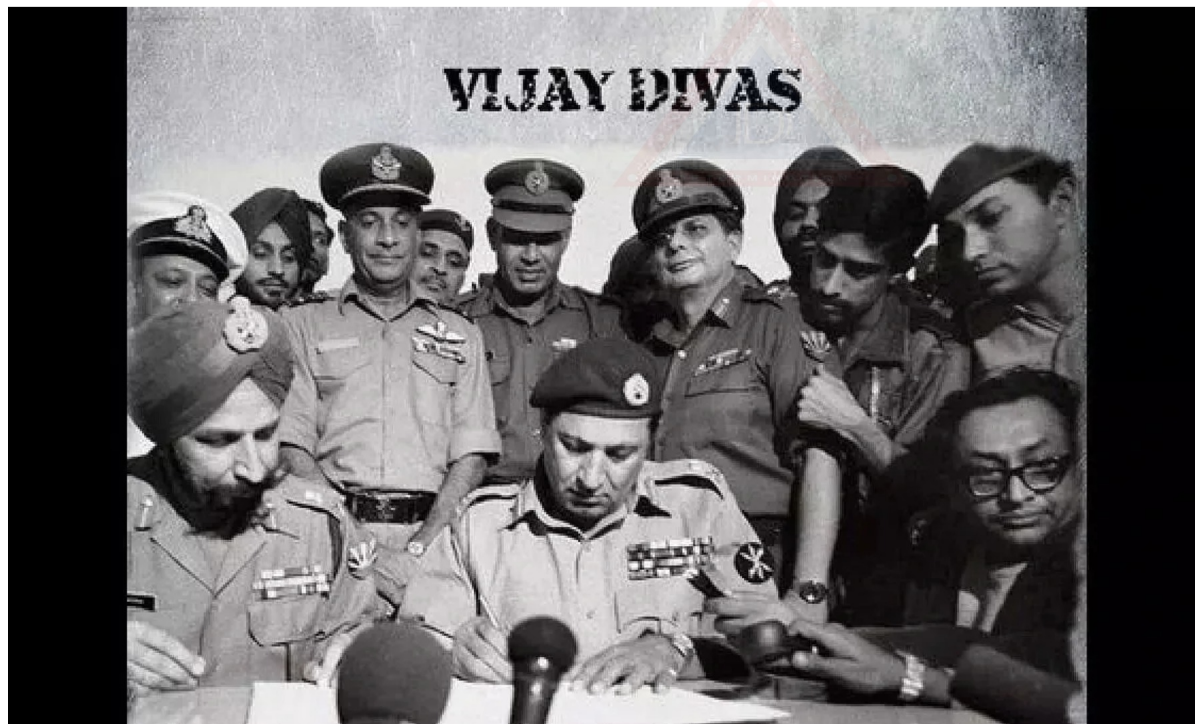
