

### **Nationality**

- The candidates must be citizens of India and possess valid documents issued by the government.
- Candidates who are not Indian citizens and want to or are permanently settled in India should be able to provide valid documents issued by the government of India validating the same.

#### **Age Limit**

As per the WB Police Constable Eligibility Criteria 2023, the age of the candidates must be within the following limit:

WB Police Constable Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

Minimum age: 18 years

• Upper age limit for WB Police Lady Constable: 30 years

• Upper age limit for WB Police Constable Male: 27 years of age

The age relaxation is as follows:

Category	Upper Age Limit Extension
SC/ST of West Bengal	5 years
OBC of West Bengal	3 yrs

#### **Educational Qualification**

The duties of a WB Police Constable involve preparing, maintaining, and updating records and registers regularly. Therefore, the candidates must possess certain minimum qualifications to perform their duties properly. The candidate must possess the following qualifications to be eligible for selection as a Police Constable with the WB Police Department:

- The candidates must have completed their Madhyamik Examination from the WB Board of Secondary Education or any other recognized school education board of India.
- The candidates should also be able to read, write, and speak the Bengali language properly.
- They should also have good reasoning ability and general knowledge, as the same will be tested during the interview round.

### **Physical Standards**

Apart from all the other WB Police Constable Eligibility Criteria 2023, the candidates must possess certain physical traits to be eligible for the vacancies. The physical standards vary according to the category of the candidates. The aspiring candidates are advised to prepare for the PMT and PET beforehand and stay fit and fine.

## WB Police Constable 2023 Exam Pattern

Examining the WB Police Constable format is similar to having a customized road map. It's crucial since it gives you advice on how to prepare, helps you prepare effectively, and gives you more confidence on test day. In your WB Police Constable Exam journey, you'll encounter four key stages:

- 1. The Preliminary Exam
- 2. PMT and PET
- 3. The Final Written Exam
- 4. The Interview

Let us now decode each of these stages for you separately in bullet points.

## **Preliminary Written Test**

WB Police Constable Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

- The test consists of 100 multiple-choice questions of 1 mark each.
- Be cautious, as there's a deduction of 1/4 of the assigned mark, i.e., 0.25 mark for each wrong answer.
- The test is available in Bengali and Nepali languages.
- You'll have a total of 1 hour, i.e., 60 minutes, to complete the test.

## PMT/PET

To qualify for the PMT and be eligible for the PET, you need to meet specific physical standards. You'll be required to run a distance of 1600 meters in less than 6 minutes and 30 seconds. If you successfully meet these standards, you'll move on to the final written exam as one of the shortlisted candidates.

### Final Written Exam

Following the PMT or PET, you will need to appear for the final written exam. The final written exam consists of 85 multiple-choice, objective-type questions.

- Each question carries 1 mark, but do be cautious as there's a penalty of 1/4 of the assigned mark, i.e., 0.25 mark for every incorrect answer.
- There's no negative marking for questions you choose not to attempt.

### Interview

In the final selection stage, you will undergo a personal interview where they will assess your personality traits and determine your suitability for the job. They will also verify your roll number and other necessary documents during this phase. If you're among the shortlisted candidates and pass the medical test, you'll be appointed as a police constable with the West Bengal Police Department. This interview holds a weight of 15 marks.
