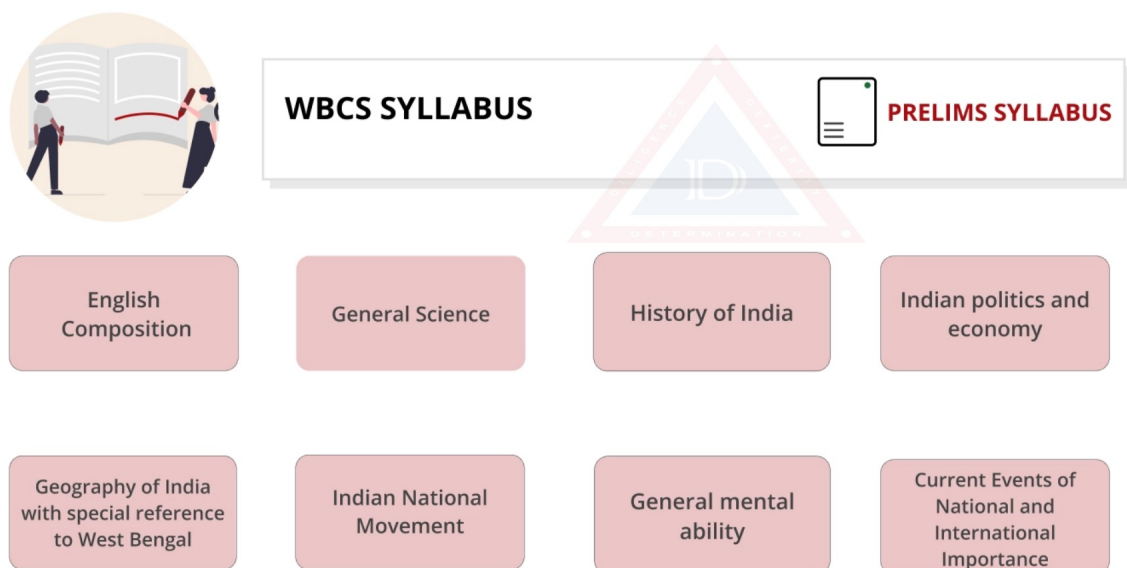




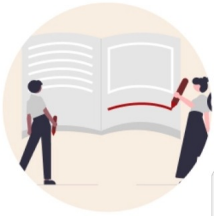

Preliminary Examination

- The Preliminary examination consists of 8 sections, each with questions at a level similar to graduation standards, testing your general knowledge.
- This paper includes 200 multiple-choice questions in an objective format.
- It carries a maximum of 200 marks.
- The exam duration is 2.5 hours.

Main Examination

- The Main Examination comprises six compulsory papers.
- For Group A and/or B candidates, the Main Examination includes two additional papers, Paper VII and Paper VIII.
- Candidates must choose one optional subject from the provided list for Paper VII and Paper VIII.
- Each paper, whether compulsory or optional, is worth 200 marks and lasts for 3 hours.

WBCS Topics 2024 - Marking Scheme
