After that, there will be a physical fitness exam where you will be required to run, jump, and lift objects to show that you can withstand the physical demands of working as a police officer. The interview stage is the last one, where you can highlight your leadership abilities, communication skills, and general fit for the position.

WBPRB Full Form - Recruitment

Different pathways determine entry at different positions in the West Bengal police service:

The West Bengal Police Recruitment Board is in charge of overseeing the recruitment process for Constables, Lady Constables, Sub Inspectors, and Lady Sub Inspectors, assuring careful selection for these important positions. Officers in the West Bengal Police Service (WBPS) are assigned to higher positions such as Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) depending on their performance in the West Bengal Public Service Commission's West Bengal Civil Service (Group-B) examination. In the meantime, those who wish to become Assistant Superintendents of Police (ASP) in the Indian Police Service (IPS) must pass the Union Public Service Commission's Civil Services Examination (UPSC). Through this advancement, officers can begin their probationary term as ASPs and eventually become Additional Superintendents of Police (ASPs), which is a crucial position in upholding law and order in the state.
