WBPSC Exam Calendar 2024 - WBCS Mains 2023

As per the WBPSC Exam Calendar 2024, the WBPSC has officially announced the WBCS exam dates for the main examination on its website. Mark your calendars because the WBCS Mains 2023 exam is set to be held on August 16th, 17th, 18th, and 20th, 2024. WBCS Main 2023 - Eligibility Criteria

You should verify your eligibility criteria before applying for the exam. It's crucial to meet the eligibility criteria before you proceed with the exam.

Age Limit

- For Group 'A' and 'C' services and posts: Your age must be between 21 and 36 years, with a birthdate from January 2, 1987, to January 1, 2002.
- For the West Bengal Police Service (Group 'B'): Your age must be between 20 and 36 years, with a birthdate from January 2, 1987, to January 1, 2003.
- For Group 'D' services and posts: Your age must be between 21 and 39 years, with a birthdate from January 2, 1984, to January 1, 2002. If your birthdate falls between January 1, 2002, and January 1, 2003 (making you 20 to 21 years old as of January 1, 2023), you are eligible to apply for Group B only.

Educational Qualification

- You must have a degree from a recognized university.
- Additionally, you need to be able to read, write, and communicate in either Bengali or Nepali.
- However, if Nepali is your mother tongue, you are exempt from this requirement as per Finance Department Notification No. 1243-F(P) dated February 23, 2016.

Nationality

- You must hold Indian citizenship, either by birth or through registration.
- Applicants from foreign countries must have a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India to appear for the WBCS exam 2023.



WBCS Main 2023 - Exam Pattern

- The Mains exam will feature both objective and conventional type questions.
- The Mains Examination consists of six compulsory papers.
- Additionally, if you are applying for Groups A and/or B, you must choose one optional subject from the list provided in the WBCS Notification 2023.
- This optional subject is divided into two papers, Paper 1 and Paper 2, each worth 200 marks.

If you're considering a career through the WBPSC Miscellaneous Services Examination, it's crucial to understand the key eligibility requirements. Here's what you need to know about eligibility for the exam:

Educational Qualifications

- You must possess a bachelor's degree from a recognized university or its equivalent.
- Proficiency in Bengali is required—you should be able to read, write, and speak Bengali fluently.
- However, there are exceptions for candidates whose mother tongue is Nepali, as stated in the Finance Department's notification.

Age Limit

- Your age must be between 20 and 39 years as of January 1, 2024.
- The age listed on your Madhyamik or equivalent certificate will be considered valid.
- This age requirement applies to all candidates, regardless of whether they are currently employed in government service.

Nationality

- You must be an Indian citizen, either by birth or through registration.
- Alternatively, if the Indian government has recognized you as a national of another country, you are also eligible to apply.

WBPSC Miscellaneous Services - Exam Pattern

The exam pattern for WBPSC Miscellaneous is as follows:

Preliminary Examination (Objective Type):

- This stage usually consists of multiple-choice questions (MCQs) designed to test your general knowledge and aptitude in various subjects relevant to the posts advertised.
- The preliminary exam serves as a screening test to shortlist candidates for the next stage of the examination process.

Final Examination (Conventional Type - Written):

- Candidates who qualify for the preliminary exam move on to the final examination, which is conducted in a conventional written format.
- This stage assesses deeper knowledge of specific subjects related to the posts, typically covering more detailed aspects of the syllabus.

WBPSC Exam Calendar 2024 - Clerkship (Part 1) 2023

The detailed notification PDF released by the West Bengal Public Service Commission (WBPSC) for the recruitment of Clerk posts was released on 4th December 2023. To qualify for Clerk positions, you must go through three stages of the recruitment process: Part I (objective type), Part II (conventional type—written), and a typing test. The WBPSC Exam Calendar 2024 has set the Part-I (objective type) exam dates for November 16th and 17th, 2024. Notably, 714,413 candidates have registered for this examination.

WBPSC Clerkship - Eligibility Criteria

If you're interested in applying for clerkship posts, make sure to verify your eligibility before submitting your application for WBPSC Clerkship Recruitment 2024.

Educational Qualifications

- To be eligible for the WBPSC Clerkship Exam 2024, you must have passed the Madhyamik examination conducted by the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education or an equivalent exam.
- Additionally, you need to have basic computer operation skills and be able to type at a speed of 20 words per minute in English or 10 words per minute in Bengali.

Age Limit

- You must be between 18 and 40 years old as of January 1, 2023.
- In other words, your birth date should be between January 2, 1983, and January 1, 2005, inclusive.
- Your age as stated on your Madhyamik or equivalent certificate will be accepted.
