WBPSC Food SI Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

- You should be an Indian citizenship, either by birth or through official registration.
- · Alternatively, you are eligible if you are recognized as a national of another country, as declared by the Indian government.

To understand it better, you can take help of the snippet attached below for your reference, taken directly from the official notification.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:	(i) The candidate must be	
	(a) A citizen of India (either natural or by registration), or	
	(b) Such other nationals as declared eligible by the Govt. of India.	
	Provided that a candidate belonging to category (b) shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government. A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to the examination but the offer of appointment may be given only after the necessary eligibility certificate has been issued to him by the Government.	
	(ii) The candidate must have good health and character and suitability in all respects for appointment to Government service.

Age Limit

- You should not be below 18 years or above 40 years as of 01.01.2023.
- In other words, to be eligible for the WBPSC Food SI position, your birthdate must fall between January 2, 1983, and January 1, 2005.
- It's crucial to highlight that your age, as documented in your Madhyamik or equivalent certificate, will be taken into account.

Age Relaxation

- Individuals belonging to the SC or ST. category in the West Bengal state are entitled to a 5-year relaxation in the upper age limit.
- OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) applicants from West Bengal can avail themselves of a 3-year relaxation in their upper age limit.
- · Candidates with benchmark disabilities (PwBD) with a disability level of 40% and above have the option to extend their maximum age limit to 45 years.
- It's important to note that if you are an S.C., S.T., or O.B.C. candidate from a state other than West Bengal, you will be treated as a general candidate regarding age limits.

Educational Qualifications

Candidates should clearly state the following qualifications in their application.

WBPSC Food SI Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

- You are required to attain a passing grade in the Madhyamik Examination conducted by the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education or an equivalent examination.
- Furthermore, you must possess the ability to read, write, and communicate either in Bengali or in Nepali. Nevertheless, if Nepali is your mother tongue, you are exempted from this requirement, in accordance with Finance Department Notification No. 1243-F(P) dated February 23, 2016.
- Candidates whose mother tongue is not Bengali will undergo a Bengali language assessment during the personality test. Furthermore, candidates who perform poorly in this assessment may have their candidature revoked.
- Lastly, it is necessary for you to be in good health and capable of undertaking extensive travel in rural areas of West Bengal.

The West Bengal Public Service Commission unveiled the WBPSC Food SI recruitment notification on August 22, 2023. - Additionally, the written exam will include multiple-choice questions.
- Lastly, this exam will span a duration of 1.5 hours.

Personality test

- Only a select number of candidates, based on their performance in the written examination, will be called for the personality test.
- The final merit list will be prepared on the basis of the scores achieved in the written exam and the scores attained in the personality test.
- · Lastly, the Personality Test will carry a maximum of 20 marks.
