## **Nationality**

- You must possess Indian citizenship, either by birth or by registration.
- Individuals from other nations as declared eligible by the Government of India.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS	(i) The candidate must be	
	(a) A citizen of India (either natural or by registration), or	
	(b) Such other nationals as declared eligible by the Govt. of India.	
	Provided that a candidate belonging to category (b) shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government. A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to the examination but the offer of appointment may be given only after the necessary eligibility certificate has been issued to him by the Government.	
	(ii) The candidate must have good health and character and suitability in all respects for appointment to Government Service.

Furthermore, if you fall into the last category, it is mandatory to possess a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India.

### **Age Limit**

- To be eligible, you should be below 20 years old and not above 39 years old as of 01.01.2023. To be specific, your birthdate must fall between January 2, 1984, and January 1, 2003.
- Please take note that the age mentioned on your Madhyamik or equivalent certificate will serve as the valid age for this application. Moreover, this criterion is applicable to all candidates, regardless of whether you are currently employed in government service or not.

#### Age Relaxation:

- In West Bengal, individuals belonging to the SC or ST category can benefit from a maximum age relaxation of 5 years.
- OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates in West Bengal are eligible for an age relaxation of up to 3 years.
- Persons with benchmark disabilities (PwBD) may have their upper age limit extended to 45 years.
- It's important to note that no age relaxation is applicable to SC/ST/OBC candidates from other states, as they will be treated as general candidates.

#### **Educational Qualification**

- You must hold a degree from a recognised university or its equivalent.
- Candidates are required to be proficient in reading, writing, and speaking in Bengali. However, it's important to note that this prerequisite is not applicable to individuals whose mother tongue is Nepali, as specified in the Finance Department's Notification No. 1243-F(P) dated March 2, 2016.
- In case your mother tongue is a language other than Bengali or Nepali, your knowledge of Bengali will be evaluated during the personality test. However, candidates who perform poorly or have average proficiency in the Bengali knowledge test might face the risk of having their candidature revoked.

QUALIFICATIONS	A degree from a recognized University or its equivalent.     Ability to read, write and speak in Bengali (not required for those candidates whose mother tongue is Nepali) – vide Finance Department's Notification No.1243-F(P) dated 02.03.2016.  Knowledge of Bengali will be tested for candidates whose mother tongue is other than Bengali/Nepali at the time of Personality Test. Candidature of the candidates with average and/poor performance in the said knowledge of Bengali Test shall be liable to be cancelled.

- The Final Merit List will be determined by considering the marks you secure in all three papers of the Final Examination and the marks from the Personality Test combined.

# **WBPSC Miscellaneous Salary**

- For job positions numbered 12 through 19, they fall within Pay Level 9, offering a salary range of Rs. 28,900 to Rs. 74,500, adhering to the ROPA, 2019 guidelines.
- Apart from the base salary, these positions provide various allowances that you are entitled to receive.
