WBPSC Miscellaneous Exam 2024 - Eligibility Criteria

When applying for any examination, it is crucial to thoroughly review the eligibility criteria. In this segment, we will briefly outline the WBPSC Miscellaneous Eligibility Criteria 2024. There are three primary eligibility requirements for the WBPSC Miscellaneous exam 2024 as outlined below:

Nationality

To be eligible for the exam, you must meet the following citizenship requirements:

- You must be an Indian citizen, either by birth or through registration.
- You can also be eligible if the Government of India has declared you as such, even if you are not an Indian by birth.

Educational Qualifications

- You should possess a degree from a recognized university or its equivalent.
- You must have the ability to read, write, and speak in Bengali, although this requirement does not apply to candidates whose mother tongue is Nepali, as per the Finance Department's Notification No. 1243-F(P) dated March 2, 2016.
- If your mother tongue is neither Bengali nor Nepali, your knowledge of Bengali will be assessed during the personality test. Candidates who perform poorly or have average proficiency in the Bengali knowledge test may have their candidature cancelled.

Age Limit (as on 01.01.2023)

- Your age should not be less than 20 years and should not exceed 39 years as of January 1, 2023. This means you must have been born between January 2, 1984, and January 1, 2003.
- It's important to note that the age mentioned in your Madhyamik or equivalent certificate will be the accepted age for this application. This age requirement applies to all candidates, whether you are in government service or not.

Understanding the WBPSC Miscellaneous Services exam pattern is like having a clear roadmap for your preparation. Preliminary Examination

You will encounter a single paper with 100 multiple-choice questions divided into two sections: General Studies (150 marks) and Arithmetic (50 marks). Each correct answer is worth 2 marks, but be aware that there will be a penalty for incorrect answers. You will have 1 hour and 30 minutes to complete the exam. This preliminary exam is a screening test to determine which candidates will advance to the final examination.

Final Examination

The final examination consists of three conventional-type question papers: Paper-I, Paper-II, and Paper-III, with a total of 450 marks. Each of Paper-I and Paper-II is worth 150 marks and has a duration of 1 hour and 30 minutes. Paper-III is worth 150 marks in total, with 100 marks assigned to General Studies (Group A) and 50 marks to Arithmetic (Group B), and the total time allotted for Paper-III is 2 hours and 30 minutes. You may answer Group-A (General Studies) questions in English, Bengali, or Nepali. For Group B (Arithmetic), answers can be given in either English or Bengali. However, all answers within a single group must be in the same language.

Personality Test

The personality test is worth 100 marks. Only a few candidates, selected based on merit from the final written examination, will be invited to participate. The Final Merit List will be determined by combining the scores from all three papers of the Final Examination with the marks obtained in the Personality Test.

WBPSC Miscellaneous Exam 2024 - How to Apply Online?

The applications for WBPSC Miscellaneous Recruitment must be submitted online. The steps to submit the WBPSC Miscellaneous applications are as follows:

Step 1: Visit the

official WBPSC website

Step 2: Now, under Candidate's Corner, click on the "WBPSC Miscellaneous Exam 2024 Apply Online" link.

Step 3: Read the application form carefully and fill it in with your personal, educational, and other details.

Step 4: Upload scanned copies of your photograph, signature, and other required documents in the prescribed format.

Step 5: Pay the application fee as per your category through the available online payment modes.









Additionally, if you are in the general or OBC category, the application fee is Rs. 160, along with any additional charges. However, if you are an SC/ST candidate from West Bengal or a Person with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) with a physical disability of 40% or more, you are exempted from paying any fees.
