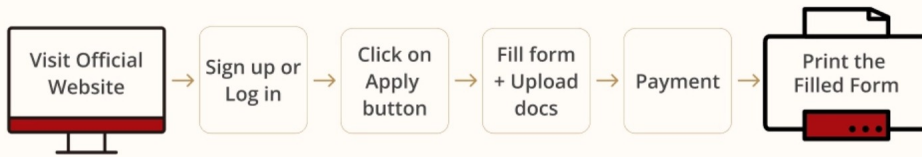

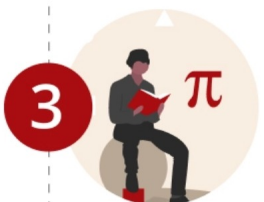

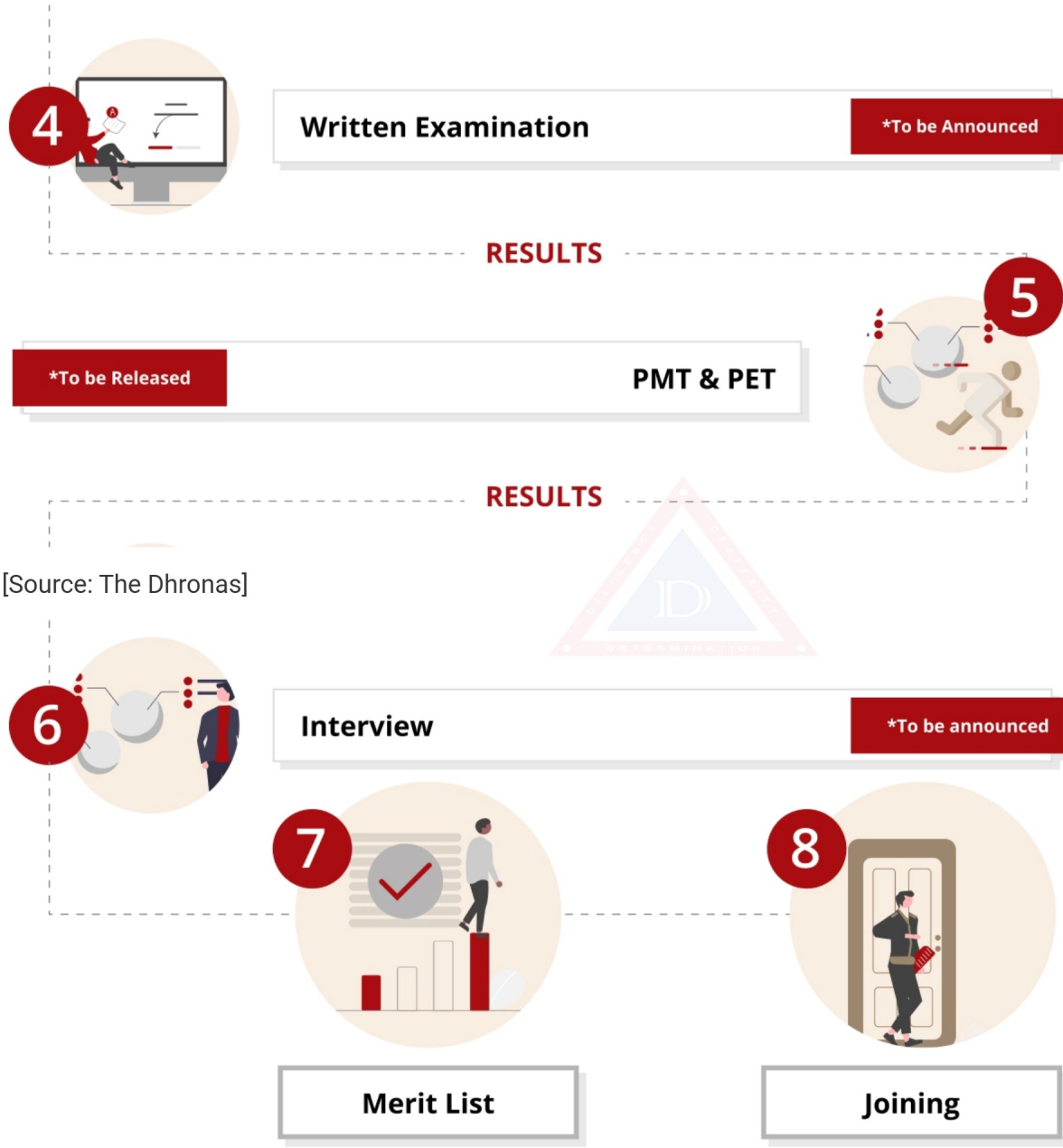

West Bengal Police Constable Recruitment 2024 Eligibility Criteria

The first and most crucial step in preparing for any exam is understanding the eligibility criteria. Therefore, you need to be familiar with the qualifying standards for the West Bengal Police Constable Recruitment 2024. Here are the key requirements for the position which would make a person eligible to apply:

1. **Nationality:** You must be an Indian citizen.
2. **WB Police Constable Age Limit:** The lower limit for West Bengal Police Constable applicants is 18 years whereas the upper limit for West Bengal Police Constable applicants is 30 years old. The upper age limit can be relaxed as follows:

Category	Age Relaxation
SC and ST	5 Years
OBC (Classes A and B)	3 Years
Third Gender	3 Years
Civic Volunteers/Village Police Volunteers	5 Years

Further, please ensure to cater to the pointers given below for your better understanding.

- By the total years of completed service for Ex-servicemen candidates, up to a maximum age of 40 (forty) years.
- NVF/Home Guards personnel serving in the West Bengal Police are also eligible for upper age limit relaxation as per existing rules

3. **Educational Requirements:** The candidate should have cleared the Madhyamik Examination from the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education or an equivalent board.

4. **Language:** Individuals must possess proficiency in speaking, reading, and writing Bengali. However, this requirement does not apply to individuals who are permanent residents of hill sub-divisions in Darjeeling and Kalimpong Districts. The provisions outlined in the West Bengal Official Language Act, 1961 (West Ben. Act XXIV of 1961) shall be applicable for them.



5. NVF/Home Guard members and Civic Volunteers/Village Police Volunteers currently serving with the West Bengal Police who wish to apply must have completed a minimum of 03 (three) years of service as of 01.01.2024.

West Bengal Police Constable Recruitment 2024 Mode of Examination

Constable positions within the West Bengal Police Constable Recruitment 2024 will be appointed based on a Written Examination, along with subsequent evaluations comprising a Physical Measurement Test (PMT), Physical Efficiency Test (PET), and Interviews administered by the West Bengal Police Recruitment Board.

Ex-servicemen are required to furnish original documents attesting to their service to be eligible for relaxation in the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) on the day of their field assessment. Third Gender individuals are expected to present an original Certificate of Identity and Identity card issued by the competent authority during the PMT & PET to validate their claim.

West Bengal Police Constable Recruitment 2024 Exam Pattern

- **Written Examination** (Maximum Marks - 85): Eligible candidates will participate in an OMR-based Written Examination comprising multiple-choice questions (MCQs). The exam lasts one hour, with 85 questions, each carrying one mark. A negative marking of $\frac{1}{4}$ th of the total marks will apply for incorrect answers. The exam will be in Bengali and Nepali.
- **Physical Measurement Test** (PMT): Selected candidates will proceed to the Physical Measurement Test (PMT), assessing height, weight, and chest measurement (for males) using Electronic Machines.
- **Physical Efficiency Test** (PET): Candidates passing the PMT will undertake PET, which is also qualifying.
- **Interview** (Maximum Marks - 15): Candidates' proficiency in Bengali/Nepali language will be evaluated during the interview.

1. In the context of recruitment for West Bengal police constables, candidates from Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes in West Bengal are only required to pay a processing fee of Rs. 20, as they are exempt from any application fees.
2. The above exemption does not extend to SC/ST candidates from other states.
3. Candidates from Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) from other states will be considered as General (Un-reserved) category candidates and will not receive any fee exemptions.
