

## West Bengal Sub Inspector Exam 2024 - Physical Efficiency Test (PET)

Your performance in the Physical Efficiency Test will be assessed based on various activities, such as the 400-meter or 800-meter run. Detailed information is provided in the excerpt below from the official notification:

#### F. Physical Efficiency Test (PET) :-

Sl. No.	Class of Candidate	Minimum Efficiency
1.	Male candidates (Both Unarmed & Armed Branch)	800 metres run within 3 minutes.
2.	Female candidates (Unarmed Branch)	400 metres run within 2 minutes.
3.	Transgender Candidates (Both Unarmed & Armed Branch)	400 metres run within 1 minute 40 seconds.

## West Bengal Sub Inspector Exam 2024 - Final Combined Competitive Examination

The Final Combined Competitive Examination consists of three papers with conventional type questions:

- **Paper I:** General Studies and Arithmetic, totaling 100 marks (50 marks for General Studies, 25 marks for Logical & Analytical Reasoning, and 25 marks for Arithmetic), with a duration of 2 hours.
- **Paper II:** English, worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.
- **Paper III:** Bengali/Hindi/Urdu/Nepali, worth 50 marks, with a duration of 1 hour.

## West Bengal Sub Inspector Exam 2024 - Personality Test

Candidates who meet all the eligibility criteria and perform well in the Final Combined Competitive Examination will be shortlisted based on merit for the Personality Test. A minimum score of 8 marks is required to pass the personality test.
